During a kyphoplasty, Dr. Le injects a cement mixture into the bone to give it strength and stability. A balloon is inserted and inflated to create an opening for the mixture. The cement is injected after the balloon is deflated and removed. It is more likely to be successful if done within two to three months of a fracture diagnosis. Patients typically have immediate pain relief and improved mobility after the procedure.

SURGICAL PROCEDURE STEPS:

- 1. Dr. Le inserts a hollow cannula though your skin using a needle tip. With the aid of fluoroscopy, a type of X-ray, this needle tip and cannula is guided to the correct position in your spinal bone.
- 2. An inflatable balloon is then introduced into the vertebral body through the cannula.
- 3. The balloon is then inflated to create the space needed for the bone cement.
- 4. Once the space has opened up, the mixture is injected to fill it up. Imaging tests will help the surgeon confirm that the mixture is distributed properly.
- 5. Once the cement is in place, the cannula is removed.
- 6. The area is bandaged. Stitches won't be necessary.

Kyphoplasty procedures usually take less than 30 minutes to perform.



FAST FACTS

- Over 30 million people in the U.S. have diabetes, a chronic metabolic disease that isn't yet curable but can be managed.
- Controlling blood sugar is crucial to managing diabetes, which, if uncontrolled, can lead to other problems such as cardiovascular disease, kidney damage, and hearing loss.
- Hearing loss is not only twice as common among those with diabetes but 30 percent higher among adults with prediabetes.
- Like age-related hearing loss, diabeteslinked hearing issues commonly take a toll on higher-frequency hearing.
- People with diabetes can have a harder time hearing speech in noisy environments such as restaurants and parties.

It's not yet known all the ways diabetes and hearing impairment are connected, but research has identified poor blood flow to the cochlea as the main culprit in hearing loss among diabetic patients.





HEALTHY WAYS TO FIGHT BACK

Diabetes may play a role in hearing loss, but you can fight back by helping reduce your overall risk of hearing impairment. **Some prevention tips:**

- Manage your diabetes if you have the disease, using strategies created with your medical doctor.
- 2. Reduce exposure to excess noise, one of the most preventable causes of hearing loss.
- 3. Eat a balanced, nutritious diet, which contributes to better ear functioning.
- 4. Avoid tobacco use, a risk factor for cancer, hearing loss, and many other problems.
- 5. Stay physically active, because excess weight not only ups the risk of diabetes but can tax your hearing.

Get your hearing evaluated by a licensed audiologist at least once a year — just like regular care for your eyes or teeth — for early testing, detection, and treatment of any problems.

Diabetes-associated hearing loss could affect one or both ears, may occur suddenly or gradually, and could appear with or without balance problems of the inner ear, but routine professional hearing checks can help catch potential issues early.

MAXIMIZING YOUR HEARING HEALTH CARE

- Schedule a hearing checkup with your audiologist at least once a year.
- Consider bringing a companion who can provide emotional support, another perspective on your hearing difficulties, and a familiar voice when trying out hearing technology.
- Tell your audiologist about your most challenging listening situations — for example, noisy restaurants, phone conversations, or other circumstances.

- Describe any changes in your hearing or balance since your last evaluation.
- Ask the audiologist to share exam results with your primary doctor and other providers on your health care team.

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
RADIOFREQUENCY ABLATION FOR PAIN MANAGEMENT

WHAT IS **RADIOFREQUENCY ABLATION?**





Radiofrequency ablation is a treatment that uses electromagnetic waves to create heat. The heat destroys the nerve tissue that's causing your pain. With the nerve destroyed, the pain signal is no longer sent.

WHAT CONDITIONS ARE TREATED BY RADIOFREQUENCY ABLATION?

Dr. Jassal uses radiofrequency ablation to help patients with chronic pain in the lower back, neck, and sacroiliac joints, which are located in the pelvis. Patients with joint pain related to arthritis may also benefit.



It's also possible to treat other pain conditions with radiofrequency ablation. The team at Spine & Pain Institute of Florida will give you a thorough evaluation to determine the best course of treatment for your symptoms.

HOW DOES RADIOFREQUENCY ABLATION WORK?

Radiofrequency ablation is minimally invasive, and the procedure typically takes less than an hour. It's performed on an outpatient basis, and patients are usually allowed to go home after a short recovery period.

Typically, you are given a local anesthetic at the treatment site. Then, using a special X-ray, Dr. Jassal inserts a needle near the nerve that's causing your pain.

Once the needle is in place, a radiofrequency current is passed through the needle to create a precise burn on the nerve. This destroys the part of the nerve responsible for transmitting pain and disrupts the signal to the brain.

Dr. Jassal will provide you with specific postprocedure instructions, and these usually include avoiding driving for 24 hours as well as resting and avoiding strenuous activity for 24 hours.

IS RADIOFREQUENCY ABLATION EFFECTIVE?

Yes. More than 70% of patients experience lasting relief with radiofrequency ablation. It usually takes 1-3 weeks for the treatment to take its full effect.

Pain relief typically lasts 6 months to 2 years, and for some patients, the pain never returns. It's possible, however, for the nerve to regrow. In these cases, radiofrequency ablation may be required again.

ARE THERE ANY RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH RADIOFREQUENCY ABLATION?

Radiofrequency ablation is a safe procedure with few risks of complications. Serious complications, such as infection and bleeding, are rare. Temporary side effects — which are also uncommon — usually only last 2-3 days.

They include:

- Localized numbness or weakness
- Mild discomfort or an increase in pain
- Swelling or bruising at the incision site

The treatment is not a good option for women who are or may become pregnant, people with an infection, or those who suffer from bleeding disorders.

- Before choosing your doctor, visit the clinic, read reviews, ask for before-and-after pictures, and
 most importantly, ask questions about how to achieve your desired results and what should be
 done to maintain them.
- Ask for a referral from your primary care doctor or dermatologist to a full-time Hair Restoration Physician who is fully equipped and trained to diagnose, treat and track your hair loss process and achieve your hair restoration goals.

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
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
